

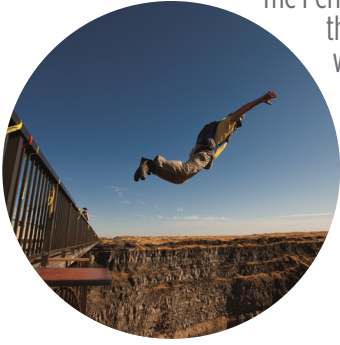
12 COOL THINGS

1 JUMP OFF A BRIDGE

The Perrine Bridge in Twin Falls is the only place in the U.S.A. where you can BASE jump year-round without a permit.



2 WORLD'S LARGEST

commercial trout farm – Clear Springs Foods.

3 IDAHO FRIES

One in every 3 French Fries consumed in the U.S.A. comes from Southern Idaho.

4 EVEL SITE

The site of Evel Knievel's 1974 attempt to jump across the Snake River Canyon is still here.

5 THE PERRINE BRIDGE

reaches across the vast Snake River 486 feet above the water.

6 MILK FLOWS

Over 27.5 million pounds of milk are produced here every day.

7 1,100 LAKES

Sawtooth National Forest has 1,100 lakes and more than 3,000 miles of rivers & streams.

8 CITY OF ROCKS NATIONAL RESERVE

rivals Yosemite National Park with more than 700 challenging climbs.



9 HIGHER THAN NIAGARA!

Shoshone Falls in Twin Falls is 45 feet higher than Niagara Falls.



10 15,000 YEARS

The region was formed over 15,000 years ago by the colossal Bonneville Flood.

11 WORLD'S LARGEST

yogurt manufacturing plant – Chobani.



12 THOUSAND SPRINGS

Thousands of natural waterfalls in Hagerman serve as the outlet for the massive Snake River Plain Aquifer that flows 1,308 beneath volcanic rock.
